

Head way out back with Kevin Sullivan's new single, Outback Australia

SOUTH Coast country singer Kevin Sullivan's song Outback Australia, is the Special Release Single from his forthcoming album, Belonging.

Although originally recorded in 2013, Kevin has re-recorded the single after it was discovered during the Tamworth Country Music Festival. The recording features award-winning artists Lyn Bowtell and Kevin Bennett on backing vocals and was produced by Simon Johnson. The country artist met Lyn and Kevin while studying at the 2018 CMAA Academy of Country Music.

"It's been an amazing experience bringing this song to life again," explains Kevin. "With the fiddle from Tim Crouch (from the US) and backing vocals from Lyn and KB, it's really added to the whole dynamic of the song. They really bring it home."

The anthemic country song already has fans across the world, with Kevin getting feedback from as far away as the UK with listeners who love it.

"I think people like the fact that the song is real Australian country music," he says.

"It came about from travelling through the outback for about 18 years. You'd be driving in the middle of nowhere in outback Queensland and you'd see some farmer out working in a paddock and you'd blow your horn and they would wave before they'd even turned around. We have the best country in the world and Outback Australia captures what it means to live here and be Australian."

Outback Australia is out on iTunes on May 4 and is now available for pre-order.

It is the Special Release Single from Belonging, Kevin's second album, which is out on May 18.

The album is a celebration of belonging, family and stories from Kevin's life as a husband, father and forensic police investigator.

From forensic police crime scene investigator to singer-songwriter, Kevin Sullivan has made the transition in style. Following his graduation at the 2018 , CMAA Senior Academy of Country Music Course, his album BELONGING debuted at No. 2 on iTunes. Kevin headlined at the iconic Birdsville Races and in 2018 played in the Emerging Artists Showcase at the Gympie Music Muster, at EKKA in Brisbane, Murrumbidgee, Mildura, Ballina and Kiama Country Music Festival.

This year a highlight so far, was in April 2019 Kevin travelled to Nashville with Award winning producer Matt Fell and recorded three new songs that will be singles on his next Album and whilst in Nashville playing on Music Row with American Country singer Kinsey Rose at the iconic Legends Corner bar.

Returning to Australia, May saw Kevin performing at the inaugural Big Country Festival in Berry NSW supporting Lee Kernaghan, The McClymonts, Travis Collins and then a house concert with the legendary Bill Chambers.

A natural storyteller and family man, Kevin played across the outback for over 18 years. He's played at many remote locations throughout Australia, from Karumba to Bourke and the Woomera Detention Centre.

Kevin's third single, No Saxophone released on June 7 originated after a chance meeting with legendary INXS band member, Kirk Pengilly who played saxophone and guitar for the Australian Super Group.

Kevin will be appearing at a number of festivals and venues including the Kiama Loves Country Festival over the June long weekend, the Mildura Country Music Festival, the Murrumbidgee Festival and in October, Kevin will also be supporting Amber Lawrence on her SPARK tour and then playing the Ballina Country Music Festival, all in the lead up to Tamworth 2020.
